Truth Points: What truth was covered this weekend in the message?	
1.	If "it is good to give thanks to the Lord" and "in everything give thanks," what are you most thankful for right now?
2.	John Stott says of this Psalm, that it calls for joyful worship, universal worship, and reasonable worship. Consider the difference between serving God as a "dreadful drudgery" and a "joyful delight." How would you describe each: duty, drudgery, or delight?
3.	Psalm 100 invites "all you lands" to worship the Lord. What does this mean for world evangelism?
4.	Read the story of 1 Kings 18. How does the declaration, "the Lord, He is God" affect the common attitude of pluralism (every culture and religion is acceptable)?
5.	Read Psalm 23. What about being "the sheep of His pasture" are you most thankful for?
6.	In light of the progressive entry described in verse 4, how are you drawing ever closer to the Lord?

7. Describe your thankfulness for the Lord's goodness, His mercy, and His enduring truth.
