## Pursuing Jesus / Discovering His Joy

Philippians, #8

**Text:** Philippians 2:12–13

Truth Points: What truth was covered this weekend in the message?

- 1. What is the command of the Holy Spirit in Philippians 2:12? How do we do it according to the context of Philippians 2:1–11?
- 2. Why is this one of the most misquoted verses in the Bible? How is it often paired with James 2:14–26? Is there a good response in these two cases that reflects the doctrine of justification by faith? What is the difference between the gift of salvation and working for salvation?
- 3. How does fear and trembling come into play in this context? What are the six motives in scripture to obey God? List them and give some examples.
- 4. Read Genesis 22. How did Abraham fear God?
- 5. Is God passive in our sanctification? What do we learn in 2:13 about God, His work, and His ambition?
- 6. Read John 15:1–5. How does this reinforce our dependence on God in serving Him or being like Him in all godliness?

Reflection Points: How does God want me to think, feel, act, and speak because of this truth?

- 1. Am I working for my salvation? Have I earned it yet? At what point do I know for sure that I have earned my salvation by works?
- 2. Do I have the gift of everlasting life? When I talk to others about Jesus, do they hear about my goodness or Jesus' goodness? His righteousness or my righteousness?
- 3. What is motivating me to obey Jesus? When was the last time I thought about my motivation? Should I? Why or why not?
- 4. Am I working out my salvation as God commands? How would I know? What would others say? Do I have the enemies that prove I am working out my salvation?

Action Points: What am I going to do this week because of this truth?

- 1. **Read** Philippians 2:14–18 for next week.
- 2. **Reflect** on Philippians 2:12–13 every day.
- 3. Ask yourself three questions every day:
  - Am I working out my salvation by thinking and caring for others before myself?
  - What is motivating me today to obey God?
  - Am I dependent on Jesus to work in me and through me today or am I going it alone?
- 4. **Share** with another follower of Jesus what you are learning about God, the Bible, Jesus, etc. Help them follow Jesus better in 2024.
